Proved at London 20th September 1816 before the Hon^{ble} Charles Cokerill Esq^r of Law & June by the oath of Charles Prosser the sole Ex^r to whom administration was granted bearing date first from July to August

In the Name of God Amen I William Presant of Great Parham in the County of Norfolk Esquire being of sound & disposing mind memory & understanding do make public & declare this my last will & Testament in manner following (that is to say) first I nominate make & appoint George Prossant my son & William Underbank of the City of Norwich Gentlemen Executors of this my will and do give to the said William Underbank ten pounds for his trouble therein also do authorize & empower order and direct them my said Executors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors as soon as conveniently can be after my decease to make sale and dispose of in such manner as they shall think proper and for the best price they can obtain for the same all & every my Messuages Tenements Grounds & other tenements as well freehold as copyhold & leasehold situate & being in Great Parham aforesaid and Bradstow in the said County of Norfolk or elsewhere whatsoever except such premises as I may have hereinafter particularly disposed of) and to bargain sell convey assign assigne the said tenements & premises to the purchaser or purchasers & thereof this act or their heirs Exors Adors or assigns or to whom he or they shall appoint and my will is that the receipt or receipts of them my said Exors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors shall be to the purchaser or purchasers of the premises respectively good & sufficient releases and discharges for all such considerations & purchase money also I further order & direct that my said Exors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors as soon as conveniently can be after my decease to make sale and dispose of all my shipping & parts of ships or vessels at sea in hand Goods Chattels & Effects whatsoever and wherever (except my furniture plate China Silver ware I have hereinafter given unto my said wife in such manner as hereinafter mentioned) and the interest arising therefrom & to order & direct shall be put & placed out by my Executors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors in their names at interest on Government Securities or other such securities as my said Executors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors shall approve of but at the risk of the principal or principals in the said securities by this my will and the interest arising therefrom to be paid to my said Exors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors towards the maintenance education & clothing of all and every my Children & after my death or demise until they severally arrive at their several respective ages of twenty one years and as they severally & respectively arrive at their several respective ages of twenty one years the equal share of the principal & interest to be paid to them as they severally & respectively arrive at such age & their several & respective receipts to be a discharge to my said Executors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors for such equal respective share also I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife all that Messuage Tenement or dwelling house with the appurtenances situate & being in Great Parham aforesaid and now in my own occupation to hold unto her the said my wife for & during the term of her natural life or intermarriage which shall first happen and in case of the death of my said wife or in case my said wife should hereafter intermarry I do order & direct that in either of those cases my said Executors or the survivor of them his Exors or Adors should make sale & dispose of my said Messuage Tenement or dwelling house with the appurtenances before mentioned for the best & most price that can be had and obtained

for the same and the monies arising therefrom I do order & direct shall be equally divided
 between them my said children whether male or female as they severally attain their
 several & respective ages of twenty one years in manner aforesaid and in the mean
 time my said Executors or the survivor of them his Executors Administrators to put in place
 out the monies in their names or Government securities or other securities as they my said
 Executors shall approve of and the interest arising therefrom to be applied towards
 the maintenance clothing & education of my said children until they severally and
 respectively attain their several & respective ages of twenty one years in manner as
 aforesaid Also I give & bequeath unto my said wife the sum of one hundred pounds
 for & during the term of her natural life or intermarriage and also all my household
 furniture plate linen China &c. &c. & all other my furniture & laborer
 for and during the term of her natural life or intermarriage which shall first appertain
 and in case my said wife should hereafter intermarry then I do order & direct that
 the sum of one hundred pounds so given & bequeathed shall be equally divided
 between all my said children & share alike and also that the said furniture shall
 be sold by my said Executors or the survivor of them his Executors Administrators and the
 monies arising therefrom invested by my said Executors or the survivor of them his
 Executors Administrators in their names in such manner as aforesaid and to be paid equally
 to & among all my said children as they shall severally & respectively attain their
 several & respective ages of twenty one years as aforesaid and the interest in the mean
 time to be applied towards their maintenance education and clothing all the rest
 residue & remainder of my Real Estate & Effects I give & bequeath the same
 equally to and amongst all my said children in manner aforesaid And I do nominate
 constitute & appoint my said son George Prettant & the said William Uthraut
 Executors of this my will and I do hereby revoke all former wills & writings whereof I the
 said William Prettant the testator have to his my last will & Testament contained
 or written on three sheets of paper (together annexed) to the first & second sheet
 my hand and to the third and last sheet my hand & seal the tenth day of April
 one thousand eight hundred and ten - William Prettant (Sd) - signed
 sealed published & declared by the said William Prettant the Testator as and for his
 last will & Testament in the presence of us who in his presence at his request in the
 presence of each other have set & subscribed our names as witnesses thereto - John
 Bearor - Fortunatus Crisp - R. Gunningham

Proved at London 19th Sept: 1816 before the Judge by the oaths of George a
 Prettant the son & William Uthraut the Exors to whom admission was granted & sworn
 first sworn by Common Oath to abide

 my will now I do hereby give & bequeath all my Estates and Effects both
 Real and personal of whatever description or kind forever unto my son Richard
 Puffett Esq. of Dapporton with in the County of Middlesex laborer to hold the
 same and every part thereof unto my said son Richard Puffett Esq. his heirs
 and assigns for ever without any benefit or legacy whatsoever to the said Kitty Cacer
 alias Catharine Cacer and do hereby behaving well & void the will made in favor
 of the said Kitty Cacer alias Catharine Cacer and all other former and other will and
 wills by me at any time heretofore made do declare this & this only to be my last will
 and Testament and do hereby appoint my said son Richard Puffett Esq. and
 my brother John Puffett Executors of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof
